



What You Can Do

Slave-Free Michigan: The “Justice for Victims of Human Trafficking” Bill

Let your representative and senator know that you want Michigan to be a state where slavery is not tolerated and victims receive justice.

Some things you can do:

1. Meet with your senator or representative face-to-face.
2. Write your senator and representative a letter or send your senator and representative an email.
3. Write a letter (your personal petition) and ask friends, neighbors, and family to sign it.
4. Get a group together to participate in a trip to Lansing to hand-deliver letters, postcards, and petitions (see below) to senators and representatives on the specified Slave-Free Michigan day later this fall (date will be forthcoming).
5. Ask religious leaders to sign the International Justice System's (IJM) petition supporting this legislation.
6. Ask organizations and businesses to sign IJM's petition supporting this legislation.
7. Sign the IJM postcard that urges senators and representatives to support the Justice for Victims of Human Trafficking bill.
8. When the “Justice for Victims of Human Trafficking” bill comes to the floor for a vote, contact your senator and representative to vote “yes” on the bill.
